
### *It's Moving Month!*

# Case of the Month!

We have a unique presentation! A 6 week old puppy named Dior presented with swelling of the muzzle and under the chin/along the neck. If this was a human child, you would almost think this is a case of the mumps! However the swelling along the neck is not the salivary glands for this puppy, it is the lymph nodes. This puppy also has a small skin infection starting- you can see some pimples on the nose that are crusting over. This is a classic appearance for a condition we see in young puppies called 'puppy strangles', or the medical term, juvenile cellulitis. The cause is unknown, but believed to be due to an over-reaction of the immune system. The good news is, most puppies respond pretty rapidly to prompt treatment, and the condition generally resolves in 1.5-2 weeks, and usually does not recur.
